**FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS
AND
CONCERNED CITIZENS FOR A BETTER ALGIERS
FOR
HRSA: ENDING THE HIV EPIDEMIC**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (the “**Amendment**”) is entered into by and between the City of New Orleans, represented by LaToya Cantrell, Mayor (the “**City**”), and Concerned Citizens for a Better Algiers, represented by Shantrice Dial, Executive Director (the “**Contractor**”). The City and the Contractor are sometimes collectively referred to as the “**Parties**.” This Amendment is effective January 1, 2023 (the “**Effective Date**”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on, January 1, 2022, the City and the Contractor entered into a subrecipient agreement for provision of the following services related to HIV/AIDS treatment: Workforce Development (the “**Agreement**”); and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor, each having the authority to do so, now desire to enter this Amendment to increase compensation, extend the term of continuity of services, and update essential terms and provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor amend the Agreement as follows:

1. **Extension.** The Agreement is extended for twelve(12) months, from the Effective Date through December 31, 2023.
2. **Compensation.** The compensation of the Agreement is increased by \$95,334.00 (Ninety-Five Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars, consisting of \$15,334.00 from FY22 HRSA Ending the HIV Epidemic and \$80,000.00 from FY23 HRSA Ending the HIV Epidemic) to a new total amount not to exceed \$155,334.00.

The compensation under this Agreement is contingent upon receipt of full Notice of Awards from the funders, and the appropriation and allocation of funds by the City. This Agreement does not guarantee any amount to fwork or compensation as specifically authorized by the City in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

3. **Additional Miscellaneous Provisions.** The following terms and conditions are added to the Agreement or restated here:
 - a. **Convicted Felon Statement.** The Contractor swears that it complies with City Code § 2-8(c). No Contractor principal, member, or officer has, within the preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony under state or federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds, bribery, or falsification or destruction of public records.

- b. **Non-Solicitation Statement.** The Contractor swears that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for it, to solicit or secure this Amendment. The Contractor has not paid or agreed to pay any person, other than a bona fide employee working for it, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from this Amendment.
- c. **Prior Terms Binding.** Except as otherwise provided by this Amendment, as amended, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
- d. **Electronic Signature and Delivery.** The Parties agree that a manually signed copy of this Amendment and any other document(s) attached to this Amendment delivered by facsimile, email or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Amendment. No legally binding obligation shall be created with respect to a party until such party has delivered or caused to be delivered a manually signed copy of this Amendment.

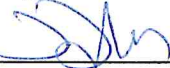

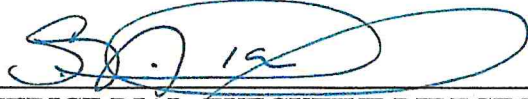
