AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO CONTRACT

FIRMIN TRUCKING, LLC

CLINICAL JANITORIAL SERVICES

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between the City of New Orleans, represented by LaToya Cantrell, Mayor (the “**City**”), and Firmin Trucking, LLC, represented by Ronald Firmin, Owner (the “**Contractor**”). The City and the Contractor may sometimes be collectively referred to as the “**Parties**.” The Agreement is effective as of August 21, 2023 (the “**Effective Date**”).

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor are parties to a contract dated August 21, 2019 and was amended on August 21, 2020; August 21, 2021, and August 21, 2023 for janitorial services (the “**Agreement**”);

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor, each having the authority to do so, desire to enter this Amendment to extend the term of the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the City and the Contractor amend the Agreement as follows:

1) **Extension**: The Agreement is extended for an additional one (1) year through August 20, 2024.

2) **Convicted Felon Statement**: The Contractor swears that it complies with City Code § 2-8(c). No Contractor principal, member, or officer has, within the preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony under state or federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds, bribery, or falsification or destruction of public records.

3) **Non-Solicitation Statement**: The Contractor swears that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for it, to solicit or secure this Amendment. The Contractor has not paid or agreed to pay any person, other than a bona fide employee working for it, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from this Amendment.

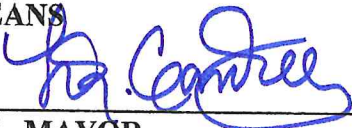
4) **Prior Terms Binding**: Except as otherwise provided by this Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

5) **Electronic Signature and Delivery**. The Parties agree that a manually signed copy of this Amendment and any other document(s) attached to this Amendment delivered by facsimile, email or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Amendment. No legally binding obligation shall be created with respect to a party until such party has delivered or caused to be delivered a manually signed copy of this Amendment.
